## What shall I do if I see someone being bullied?

Tell an adult straight away  
Don't get involved you might get hurt

## If you are being bullied

### Don't:

**What ever they do to you don't do it back.**

**Become the bully**

**Act tough**

**Get upset**

**Don't react to them.**

**Blame yourself it's not your fault**

## Tips for staying safe online:

- Only play games that are safe and appropriate for your age. Some are for older children.
- Check every download, app and attachment - they might contain a virus or be a scam.
- Keep your personal information private - such as your full name, address, school and passwords.
- Always tell a grown-up you trust if you feel upset or worried about what has happened online.
